Making the Pipes "Speak" (Final Edition)



I sincerely hope that each and every one of you have had an enjoyable Christmas.

As noted above, this is my final edition of Making the Pipes "Speak" a series of twenty-four articles that I have enjoyed writing covering various items of interest about theatre organs as part of my "Sharing the Theatre Organ Experience". As of the January 9, 2025 chapter meeting, I will not be pursuing a second two-year term as chapter president.

As noted in the December 2024 Windline and announced at the recent Chapter Christmas Party a temporary change in dates for the programs was set up for a three-month trial beginning with the December 12 Christmas party in an attempt to improve attendance for our monthly programs. We began a three-month trial period of having the programs on the second Thursday of the month rather than the third Friday of each month. After the February 13th program, there will be a review of the attendance levels for the trial period, after which a decision will be made to either maintain the new program dates or revert back to the third Friday of the month dates as well as look at other options to improve attendance.

As a result of the date change and the Monday through Thursday evening operation of the Tulsa Tech Truck Drivers' training program, the following changes for conference center access will be in effect: All vehicles will enter the Tulsa Tech east entrance on Olive Avenue rather than the 4000 W Florence Avenue south entrance. Vehicle parking will be in the north Tulsa Tech parking area, not the south half of the East Tulsa Tech parking area. Curbside vehicle access to the Conference Center Entrance Doors will not be available due to the ongoing training program. Park in the NORTH lot. The sidewalk will lead to the north conference center entrance.

Nominations for the following chapter 2025 – 2027 board positions are being accepted for the following elected positions: president, 1st vice president, 2nd vice president, treasurer, and secretary.
